



4. Removal of Front Panel Mechanism ASSY

1	Remove the screws fixed to the installation plate.		In pump-down work, be sure to stop the compressor before disconnecting the refrigerant pipe. If the refrigerant pipe is disconnected with the compressor operating and the stop valve open, air may be sucked in to generate an over-pressure in refrigeration cycle, thus resulting in pipe rupture or accidental injury.
2	Hold the indoor unit up with a block. Disconnect the pipings with 2 wrenches.	(R12141)	 Place a plastic sheet under the drain pan to prevent from wetting the floor with remaining drain. If the drain hose is embedded in the wall, disconnect the drain hose beforehand. When the pipings are disconnected, protect the both openings of pipe side and unit side from entering of moisture.
